

Study Title: Predicting and Enhancing Connecticut Breast Cancer Survivors' Health Behaviors

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Sponsor: Connecticut Breast Health Initiative

The purpose of this research is to understand more about how CT breast cancer survivors engage or do not engage in health behaviors after their treatment.

Inclusion:

A woman can participate in this study if she:

- 1) Lives in CT
- 2) Has recently been diagnosed with stages 0-III breast cancer for the first time
- 3) Is 18 years of age or older
- 4) Completed adjuvant therapy (i.e., chemo and/or radiation therapy) within 6 months.

Additional inclusion/Exclusion:

- Survivors who are on hormonal therapy or receiving targeted therapy for HER2 can take part in this study.
- A survivor who completed surgery but did not need additional treatment can take part in this study.
- Women who have serious mental disorders and cognitive disabilities and those who are not fluent in English cannot participate in this study.
