is a screening test for colorectal cancer that looks at the whole colon for precancerous polyps.



Over 90% of colorectal cancer is found in people **50 YEARS AND OLDER.**

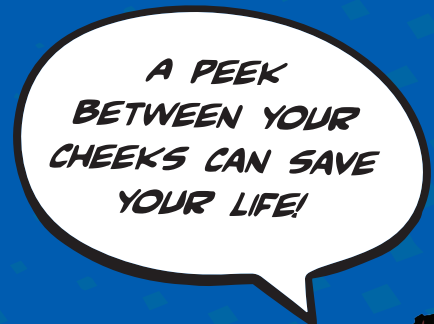
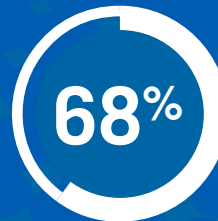
